Supply and Demand

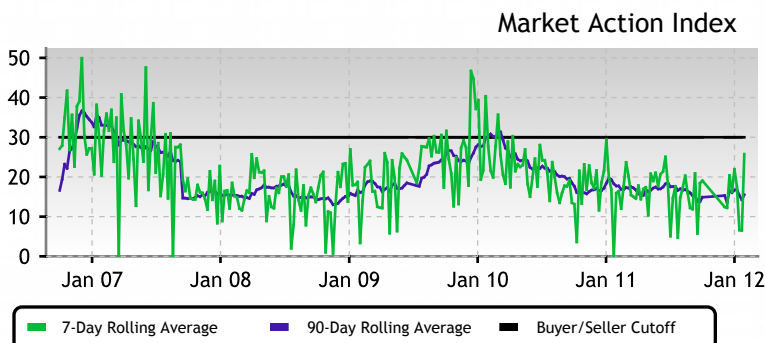
- Home sales have begun exceeding new inventory. While still a Buyer's market, prices seem to have already started to respond. If the trend continues, expect prices to keep marching upward.

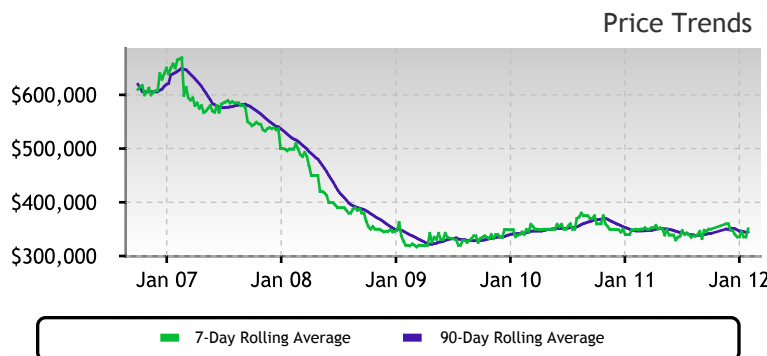

- The market for this zip code continues its bounce again this week. We're a long way from the market's high point so watch the Market Action Index to predict how long this trend will last.



The Market Action Index answers the question "How's the Market?" by measuring the current rate of sale versus the amount of the inventory. Index above 30 implies Seller's Market conditions. Below 30, conditions favor the buyer.
